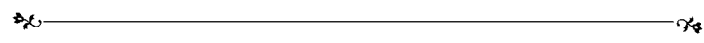

Where: Anywhere, your home, at church, during Adoration or at the abortion clinic.

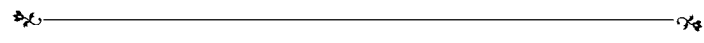
When: The time is now for us to empower prayer for the sanctity of life. Please Help!

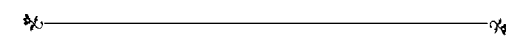
