Sidewalk Advocates for Life training employs a compassionate, woman-centered approach to take the crisis out of crisis pregnancies through education, conversation, and practical help.

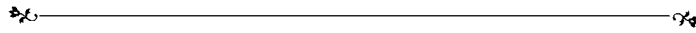
Two types of volunteers work together in this ministry: counselors engage the women in conversation while prayer partners intercede on their behalf.

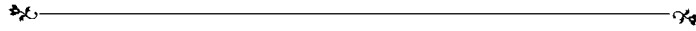

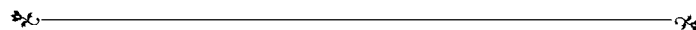
