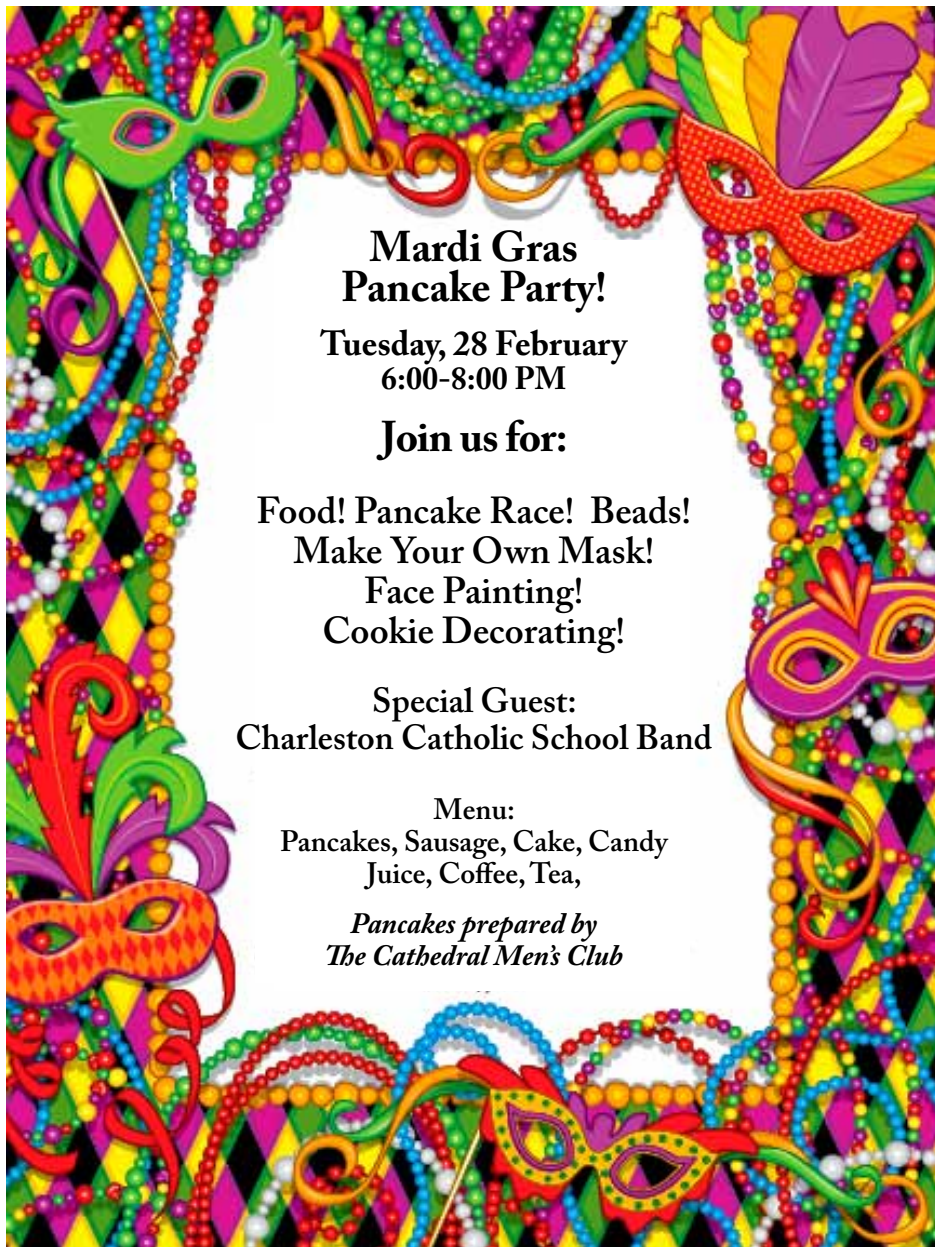
Religious Education News

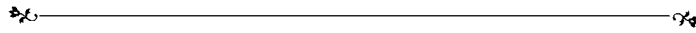

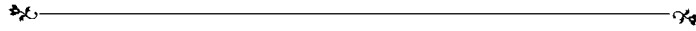
