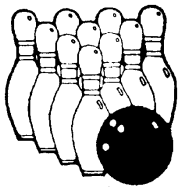
Summer Confession Schedule: Effective 30 May 2016, the Wednesday evening confessions are suspended. They will resume after Labor Day.
