Dear Parishioners,

I wanted to update you on the parish Mass schedule and priest assignments to the Cathedral and St. Mary's. As you are aware, currently I am the only priest assigned to St. Mary of the Annunciation and the Cathedral Parishes. I don't expect a second priest to be assigned to St. Mary's any time soon. We are blessed to have Fr. John Bosco helping out on Sunday morning. Fr. John Bosco is the Catholic Chaplain at MUSC Hospital and celebrates the 8:30 am and 11:00 am Sunday Masses at St. John's Parish in North Charleston, and generously has offered to drive to St. Mary's to celebrate our 9:30 am Sunday Mass when his schedule permits. This Sunday, we welcome Fr. Bernard Onikwe who is driving from Columbia, SC to celebrate Mass for us at St. Mary's.

Unfortunately, given the Mass schedule at the Cathedral, I am currently unable to be at St. Mary's on Sunday. Also, since we do not have a second priest, I will be unable to restore the 7 am daily Mass for the foreseeable future. However, there are several daily Masses offered in the area: Cathedral at 12:05 pm; Christ Our King, Mt. Pleasant at 7:00 am; Blessed Sacrament Church, Charleston, at 6:30 am; St. Patrick Church at 8:00 am.

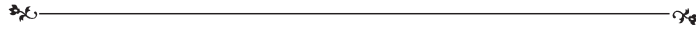
