The new Finance Council will hold its first meeting this Tuesday at 7:00 PM in the parish hall.

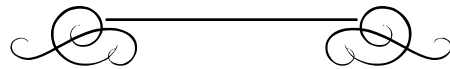
The new Pastoral Council will hold its first meeting on Monday, October 30th at 6:30 PM in the parish hall.

Vigil location:

Public right-of-way in front of Charleston Women's Medical Center/abortion facility:
 1312 Ashley River Road,
 Charleston, South Carolina 29407
 (Corner of Ashley River Road and Fuseler Road).

Parking:

Please park in the grass along the side of Fuseler Road, as close as possible in front of the pink, white, and blue 40 Days for Life truck. At night (6PM-6AM) and on the weekends, you may park in the One Carriage Lane lot on the side closest to Ashley River Road, but not in the spaces directly in front of the buildings. If you park directly in front of the Carriage Lane buildings (any time day or night), you will be towed.

The abortion facility:

There are two sets of yellow lines on the driveways of the facility. You may not cross the second yellow line or you will be trespassing. Do not obstruct anyone's passage on the street or in the driveway. Stay out of the driveway. Make sure that any signs you carry do not obstruct the view of anyone leaving the parking lot, and do not leave chairs or signs unattended in front of the building.

Literature:

Feel free to hand out literature to vehicles entering or leaving the parking lot but do not stop vehicles in the roadway or block traffic.

Convenience:

You may want to bring the following: umbrella, chair, bug spray, jacket, sunscreen, water, and prayer materials.

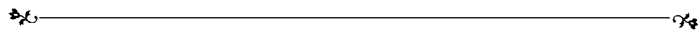

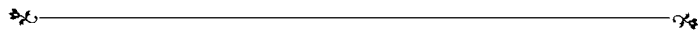
